The importance and value of **disarmament education** has been consistently recognized in United Nations resolutions and documents. The overall objective of disarmament and non-proliferation education and training is to **impart knowledge and skills** to individuals and to **empower them to make their contributions,** as national and world citizens, to the achievement of concrete disarmament and non-proliferation measures and the ultimate goal of general and complete disarmament under effective international control.

6 Key facts about the Disarmament Education Dashboard

- 1. A global **online learning platform,** created and managed by the United Nations Office for Disarmament Affairs Vienna Office, offering **free training at various proficiency levels** to diverse audiences.
- 2. A joint endeavour of the **Disarmament and Non-Proliferation (DNP) Education Partnership**, launched in 2016 and regularly **updated** and **upgraded** to reflect innovations in e-learning.
- 3. Comprised of **over 12,000 registered users** from across the globe, diverse actors, backgrounds and age groups. **More than 60% are women**.
- 4. Flexible and adaptable, suitable to host self-paced, instructor-led and blended courses, as well as webinars and workshops.



- 5. Wide range of topics covered. Over **240 thematic** modules combined to create courses on all key areas of disarmament, non-proliferation and arms control as well as cross cutting issues.
- 6. **Interactive** and **accessible** on all types of devices and **tailored** to meet the needs of those **living with disabilities**.








